

Sorting Nature at the LCCC Arboretum

- 1. Children collect nature items found on the ground into paper bags
- 2. Sort the items into large baskets or boxes by categories, for example:

First by color, second by shape, third by type of leaves or needles fourth by size, fifth by whether alive or non-alive, then by other classes depending on the season or what items were collected

- 3. For each classification, count the number in each category
- 4. On the picnic tables, create a large chart of the number of objects to measure which category had the largest number each time items were sorted
- 5. Use the items in a different way: make patterns with nature on the tables
- 6. Photograph the nature items in their sets and in patterns to discuss when back in your classroom
- 7. Return the nature to the ground.
