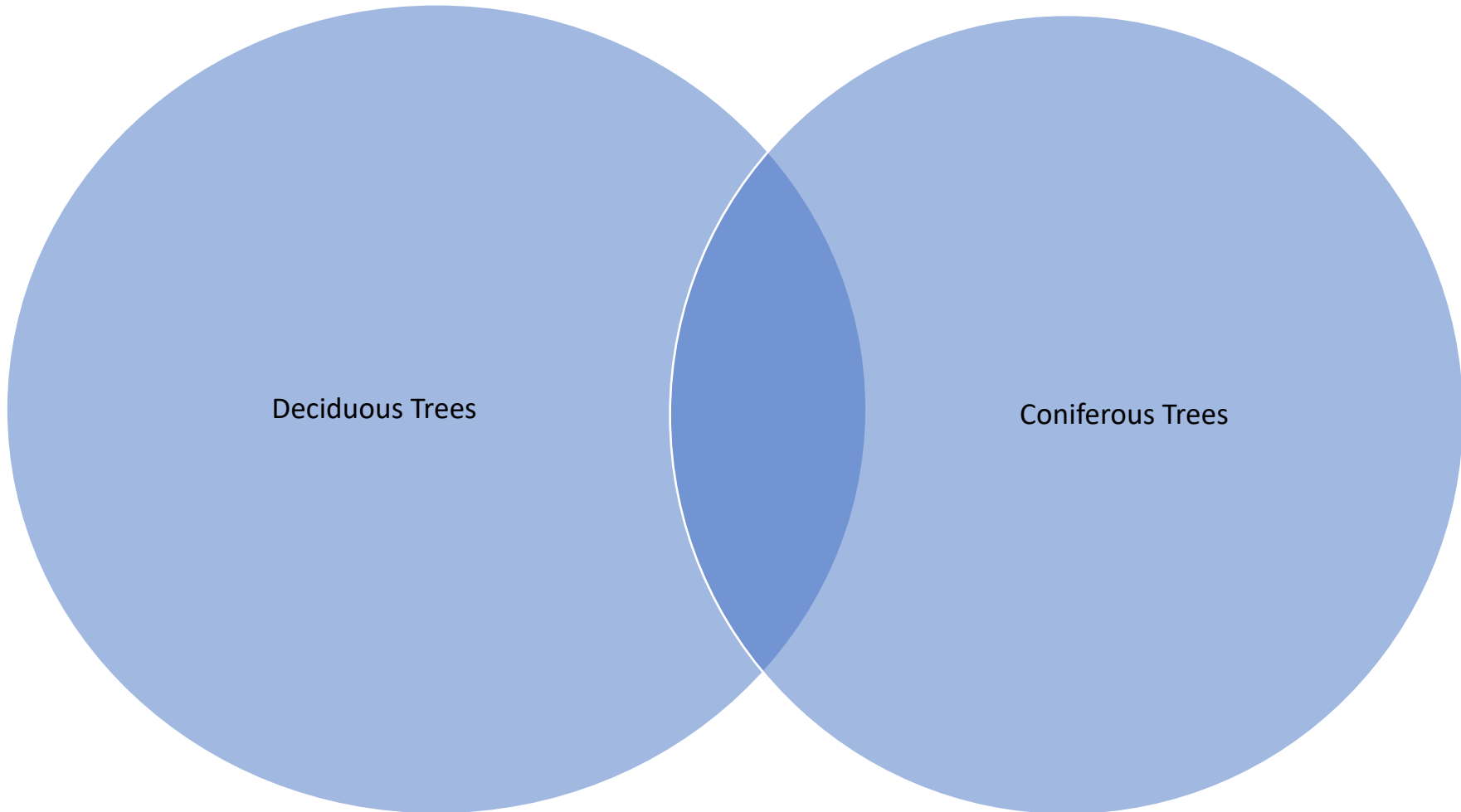


Venn Diagram: In what ways are these types of trees that same and in what ways are they different?

Deciduous Trees	Both Types of Trees	Coniferous Trees
<p>Leaves fall each autumn Leaves grow in spring from buds Leaves turn colors in the fall Some types have flowers or fruit Reproduces by seed dispersal or by clones/tree sprouts</p>	<p>Both capture sunlight, carbon dioxide, and water and turn it into food for the tree Both shelter animals and insects who live in them</p>	<p>Needles retain water better than deciduous leaves Captures more sunlight because needles stay on the tree year round Have pine cones Reproduces by bearing cones</p>
