Eligibility

The student must successfully master the task list outlined for the listed CTE secondary program of study and apply to the listed LCCC Degree program in order to be eligible for articulated transfer credits.

Requirements

- 4. The student must complete the technical program of study with a B average or better. The student will need to request a transcript be sent from the secondary technical school to LCCC.
- 5. In order to receive credits and have them posted on the college transcript, the student must successfully complete (grade of C or better) a three-credit college-level course at LCCC. Articulated credits will not be used to calculate the student's grade point average.
- 6. This articulation agreement and awarding of credit is acceptable for up to three years after the student has graduated from the CTE secondary program. Students who apply for credit after the three-year period must be able to document that they have been employed or are currently working in an area related to their CCTI program.
