Registration for Winter and Spring Sessions Is Open

Registration for classes offered throughout the spring 2023 semester is now available to all new and continuing students. Students can register online for courses that are offered in person, online or remotely, or in a hybrid format. The 14-week spring session starts Jan. 23 and ends May 15, 2023. In addition, LCCC offers several accelerated spring semester options. There are two 7-week sessions - the first is held from Jan. 23 through March 12 and the second runs March 19 to May 15. A 10-week option begins Feb. 20.

Registration for the accelerated winter online session, which runs Dec. 19, 2022, through Jan. 19, 2023, is also available now. Information is at www.LCCC.edu/winter.

New students can apply for admission at www.lccc.edu.

Tuition and fees for LCCC's winter session and spring semester are due on or before Dec. 7, and after that date are due at the time of registration. Title IX for Higher Education Annual Online Training

To All Faculty and Staff:

Title IX for Higher Education Training

As part of the college's annual sexual violence awareness trainings, this year's Title IX online training will be provided by Knowbe4 and will consist of three separate online training sessions.

Knowbe4 is a single sign-on system that will enable to you log in using your portal username and password.

This training is mandatory for all employees and must be completed annually. The deadline for completing all three trainings is Friday, November 18, 2022.

Below is the schedule that you will be notified via email from Knowbe4 of the following trainings:

Date to receive email notification from Knowbe4:

- 1. October 10, 2022 Title IX Part 1: Requirements and Responsibilities (approx. 8 minutes in length)
- 2. October 17, 2022 Title IX Part 2: Recognizing Misconduct (approx.11 minutes in length)
- 3. October 24, 2022 Title IX Part 3: Reporting and Response (approx. 14 minutes in length)

All three online trainings must be completed by November 18, 2022. Your participation and completion of these trainings will be automatically logged by the Knowbe4 system.
