Updated COVID-19 Guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) effective August 11, 2022 can be found here. This updated guidance no longer differentiates between those who are vaccinated and those who are

unvaccinated. The CDC advises that those individuals exposed to COVID-1, regardless of vaccination status,

If you were exposed to someone with COVID-19, follow these steps per the CDC guidelines: Start precautions immediately: Wear a high-quality mask for 10-full days as soon as you find out you were exposed (day 1 is the first full day after your last exposure) Get tested at least 5 full days after your last exposure Watch for COVID-19 symptoms such as: Fever (100.4 degrees or greater)

 Other COVID-19 symptoms If you develop symptoms, isolate immediately 2. Isolation and Precautions for People with COVID-19.

If you test positive for COVID-19, follow the steps below per the CDC guidelines: Stay home and isolate for at least 5 days and isolate from others in your home. If you had no symptoms, day 1 of isolation is the following day you were tested. If you had symptoms, day 1 of isolation is the first full day after the day your symptoms started.
