Graphing Calculators Available to Loan

The library has a limited quantity (30) of TI-83+ graphing calculators for students to borrow. Students must be registered for a course that requires a graphing calculator to be eligible to borrow one. Students will be asked to provide the library with a copy of the relevant course syllabus that lists a graphing calculator as a course requirement.

Students who need a graphing calculator should contact the library. Similar to the laptops and hotspots, students will need to sign a loan agreement for the calculator. Calculators may also be sent to the Donley and Morgan centers upon request.

LCCC and Drexel University Sign Agreement to Streamline Transfer Admissions

Graduating students from LCCC have an additional option for continuing their higher education thanks to an agreement between LCCC and Drexel University.

The agreement between the two institutions is designed for eligible graduates of programs with undergraduate equivalents at Drexel. Engineering students from LCCC will be able to enter any of the 10 Drexel Engineering programs. And, any LCCC graduate with an associate degree can enter the Drexel General Studies program.

In addition, the Drexel Promise scholarship, which began in the fall 2023, offers a 50% tuition scholarship at Drexel to eligible community college graduates. To be eligible for the promise scholarship, students must be enrolled full-time at Drexel, on-campus and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA for a maximum of 12 academic quarters.

Quick Reference for Medical Emergencies on Campus

If serious injury or illness occurs on campus, CALL 911. After you call 911, call Public Safety at x1169 to inform them you called 911. Public Safety will report to where the injured person is until arrival of the ambulance. For minor injury or illness, trained personnel should provide basic first aid care. Call

Public Safety at x1169. All Public Safety officers are trained in first aid and CPR/AEDS.

No employee shall transport another employee/student to an emergency facility or hospital.
