
- Goes above and beyond their job description

Increase in Mileage Rate New mileage rate as of July 1, 2022. The IRS announced an increase in the standard mileage rate starting on July 1, 2022. Any mileage from January 1, 2022 – June 30, 2022 should be at .585 per mile rate. Any mileage from July 1, 2022 – December 30, 2022 will be at .625 per mile rate. Please use separate Travel Expense Vouchers for mileage happening prior to June 30, 2022 and mileage starting as of July 1, 2022. This will insure that you are paid at the correct rate.
