who are unvaccinated. The CDC advises that those individuals exposed to COVID-1,

 Start precautions immediately: Wear a high-quality mask for 10-full days as soon as you find out you were exposed (day 1 is the first full day after your last exposure)

If you were exposed to someone with COVID-19, follow these steps per the CDC guidelines:

 Get tested at least 5 full days after your last exposure Watch for COVID-19 symptoms such as: Fever (100.4 degrees or greater)

- Cough Shortness of breath
- If you develop symptoms, isolate immediately 2. Isolation and Precautions for People with COVID-19.

Stay home and isolate for at least 5 days and isolate from others in your home.

If you test positive for COVID-19, follow the steps below per the <u>CDC guidelines</u>:

 If you had no symptoms, day 1 of isolation is the following day you were tested. If you had symptoms, day 1 of isolation is the first full day after the day your symptoms started.
