Governor Signs State Budget The state budget has been signed by Gov. Wolf and is Act 1A of 2022. It:

Appropriates \$256,510,000 to community colleges for operating, an increase of 4.6% over FY 21-22. Its distribution includes an amount off the top for the new community college, Erie Community College. LCCC's allocation is \$607,676 or 4.4%.


Appropriates \$54,161,000 to community colleges for capital, an increase of 4% over FY 21-22. Appropriates \$7 million for dual enrollment grants. There is no authorizing legislation for the distribution of these grants. However, we have been advised that there is a plan for these grants and that it is tied to language in the School Code.
