


Rothrock Library - 4 Clicks to a Good Book

All submitted reports are viewed by the Associate Dean of Student Development, the Director of Public Safety and the Dean of Student Development, Equity and Inclusion. In general, you will be contacted by the Associate Dean of Student Development, Brian DeLong, when you submit a report. StART's mission is to maintain a healthy, safe environment for all members of the college community. StART is currently utilized for online reporting of possible violations of the LCCC Code of Student Conduct (behavior concern); possible violations of the Academic Honesty Policy (academic dishonesty); injuries that take place during class (course related injury); and Public Safety reports. Increase in Mileage Rate

The IRS announced an increase in the standard mileage rate starting on July 1. Any mileage from Jan. 1-June 30 should be at .585 per mile rate. Any mileage from July 1-Dec. 30 will be at .625 per mile. Please use separate Travel Expense Vouchers for mileage happening prior to June 30 and mileage starting as of July 1.
