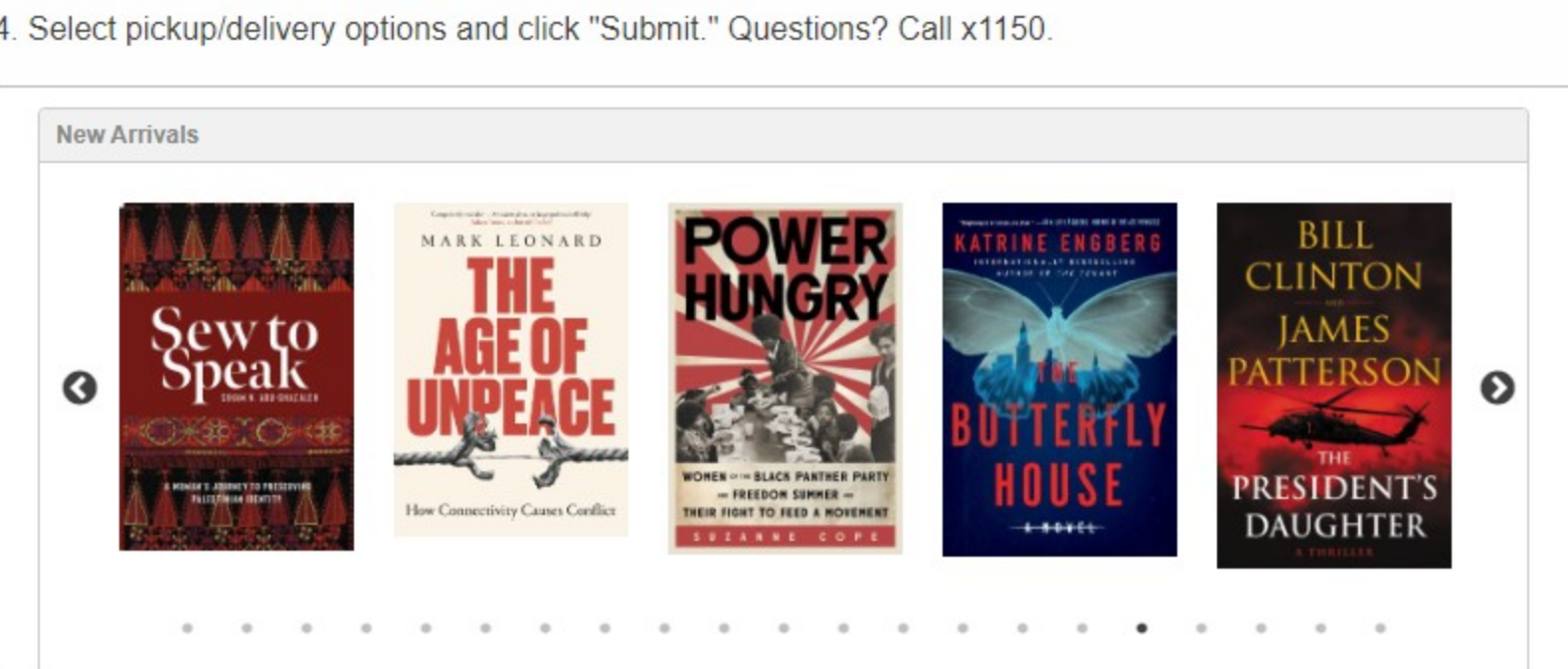
Tickets are \$8/person, which will get you one round of mini golf and a small ice cream.

StART is LCCC's online reporting system. All submitted reports are viewed by the Associate Dean of Student Development, the Director of Public Safety and the Dean of Student Development, Equity and Inclusion. In general, you will be contacted by the Associate Dean of Student Development, Brian DeLong, when you submit a report. StART's mission is to maintain a healthy, safe environment for all members of the college community. StART is currently utilized for online reporting of possible violations of the LCCC Code of Student Conduct (behavior concern); possible violations of the Academic Honesty Policy (academic dishonesty); injuries that take place during class (course related injury); and Public Safety reports.
