and is finalizing the contract in order to move forward with athletics this next academic year. We anticipate a final contract will be signed in the next few


CSC Flooring Project Completed The flooring renovation in the CSC ballroom and lobby is now complete. The

carpeting has been replaced by new luxury vinyl. Below are photos of the


