Lehigh Carbon Community College (LCCC) recognizes that faculty, staff and students of our community may use names other than their legal first names to By selecting a preferred/chosen first name, the individual is agreeing to be referred to by this name in college-related systems (i.e. Banner, Canvas, and Degree Works) and documents as well as email communications, interactions

and any processes in which names are used to address an individual, except

Students, faculty, and staff can change their preferred name in Self-Service

Note: A preferred/chosen first name is not a legal name change. Students who are legally changing their name should follow the instructions here. Faculty and staff who are legally changing their name should contact Human

when the use of the legal name is required by law or the college.


