

would know (for instance, your password) and something only you have access to (a personal device such as your mobile phone).

What happens if I do not enroll before the deadline? If you are not enrolled at the deadline you will need to enroll to access many LCCC services including myLCCC portal, Canvas and ALL applications configured to sign in with your LCCC identity (https://identity.lccc.edu)

This method of keeping accounts secure works because while someone may get your password (like through

phishing) the chances of other factors being compromised at the same time is relatively low.


