Air Handlers Replaced on Schnecksville Campus

Beginning in July and continuing through December, the college will undergo a large project to replace the air handler units in the Academic Resources Center, Science Hall and Student Services Center. During this time, there will be varying levels of air conditioning and heating while the work takes place in these buildings.

We have scheduled the work to lessen the impact on those in the buildings during those seasons (e.g. - work will begin in the ARC during the summer when the fewest number of students are present). Along with variations in building temperatures, there will be levels of construction that may cause noise and/or inconvenience. The contractor will be providing supplemental air while the work progresses, but at times it may not meet the level people have been accustomed to. Please be patient during this construction project. We recommend you make preparations to make yourself comfortable.

PRISM Knowledge Share - Pride Flags

Ever wondered where the Pride flag came from and what it means?

The original Pride flag was designed in 1978 by Gilbert Baker. Inspired by a night out dancing in a ballroom that brought together a diverse group of people, all dressed and dancing in their own way. He saw a rainbow of people and created the rainbow flag to represent them. Each color was given meaning and became the new symbol of Pride in place of the pink triangle.

Dollar General Grant

The Lehigh Carbon Community College Foundation recently received a \$9,700 grant from the Dollar General Literacy Foundation (DGLF) to support LCCC's Adult Literacy Program. The funds will be used to purchase a comprehensive curriculum for noncredit English as a Second Language students that focuses on academic preparation, civics knowledge, career readiness and technology integration.

The project, "Career Pathways ESL: Instruction to Support Adult Students as Workers, Family Members and Community Participants," will help to strengthen literacy initiatives, benefitting students in face-to-face and remote ESL courses. The program will impact approximately 125 students and help them to increase the language skills they need every day. The internet-based curriculum will integrate with the existing career pathways program for maximum impact. The targeted lessons include career exploration, soft skill instruction and content applicable to more than 180 career options, making the program exceptional for improving workplace communication.

This grant comes during their 30th anniversary year and is a part of the Dollar General Foundation's largest, one-day literacy donation of more than \$13 million throughout the 47 states in which Dollar General operates. DGLF supports organizations that increase access to educational programming, stimulate and enable innovation in the delivery of educational instruction and inspire a love of reading. Each year, DGLF awards funds to nonprofit

organizations, schools, and libraries within a 15-mile radius of a Dollar General store or distribution center to support adult, family, summer and youth literacy programs.
