Attendance - How to take Attendance in your Canvas Course

You can use the Canvas Attendance feature as a tool to help you keep track of attendance to then input this into BannerWeb. To read about the instructions of how to mark attendance view the directions below. To further see them in action and other attendance related instructions view our Online learning page on How to Take Attendance in Canvas.

- 1. Click on the Attendance button from the course navigation panel inside your course. This will load your current class roster in the list view.
- 2. To quickly mark everyone in the class as present click on the Mark All Present button.
- 3. To quickly mark individual student's attendance you can keep clicking on the button to toggle between the attendance markings: present, absent, late, and unmarked.
- 4. You can also see these options by clicking on the more button on the individual student's row and then clicking the option you wish to mark them.
- 5. You can also navigate to other dates by toggling through the date options in the left hand corner or clicking on the calender to open up a calendar for you to choose a future or past date.
